- All costume payments are mandatory and non refundable.
- Elite Dance Company has a no-refund policy on all payments.

- ★ Make Up Class Policy: Students are allowed to make up missed class time in another class of their age group – please send an email to the studio letting us know if you will be coming to a makeup class. They should be done within the month that your child missed their original class. Make up classes do not carry into the next year. Makeup classes are not mandatory and it is the <u>parent's responsibility to schedule</u>. EDC does not give refunds for missed classes.

 - Spring Break and Winter Break closures are built into the payment schedule- no make up classes needed! Enjoy the time off with your family!

- ★ Attendance Requirements: It is important that students participate in as many registered classes as they are signed up for. If you are not able to make it to class, please email or call the front office to let your teacher know. Starting April 1st, failure to show up for 3+ classes may result in your child not being able to participate in the full June Recital. There will be no refunds given for a missed class.
- ★ If a registered student wants to drop a class please submit the request through email or a written note to the front office. If you decide to drop a class at any time, you are not subject to a refund.
- ★ If your child misses a class due to sickness or snow days they are able to make up the time in another class for their age group. Please see our schedule for class options and contact elitedancemc@gmail.com to schedule. Makeup classes should be done within the semester class was missed, they do not carry into the next year. Makeup classes are not mandatory and it is the parent's responsibility to schedule. EDC does not give refunds for missed classes.
- ★ All students are encouraged to take multiple classes to strengthen their dance knowledge and technique! We understand this may result in down time in between classes. Please note that EDC is not responsible for your student during this time, but they are able to sit in the front waiting area.
- ★ Please label your child's shoes and bag to avoid any lost items. Please arrive five minutes early and have your child's shoes on before start time. All students should bring in their labeled bag,

additional labeled shoes, and a water bottle. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately (see class descriptions and attire).

- ★ Students & parents are not allowed in the classroom without an instructor present.
- ★ Dancers & siblings in the waiting areas should always be supervised by a parent. Please make sure your children are not running up and down the hallway, blocking the hallway, or spreading toys around the waiting room floor so we can avoid any accidents.
